Distribution conditions

Palette is maximum 120 x 100 cm. If larger, we switch to loading metres. Weight is maximum 1,000 kg for Belgium and 800 kg for the Netherlands.

Delivery between 24.00 and 48. hours.

Wallonia between 48.00 and 72.00 hours.

Per delivery/load :

- 15 minutes are free up to and including 3 pallets.
- 30 minutes are free from 4 to 10 pallets
- 45 minutes are free from 11 to 20 pallets
- 60 minutes are free from 21 to 28 pallets

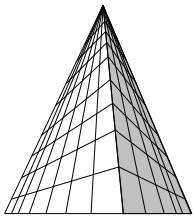
Waiting hours and/or extra hours will be charged at 55 euros per hour.

Delivery of the goods takes place at ground level, at the latest to the place where the driver can reasonably reach with pallet truck and/or hand trolley.

Loading and unloading are expressly for the Client's account and risk, even if the Client makes use of the services of the carrier's personnel for this purpose.

On passing on the instructions, in good time before the commencement of the work, the Client shall notify the Contractor in writing:

- Of the correct and accurate description of the goods including type, number, weight, condition and hazard class.
- Of all instructions and restrictions relating to the protection, handling or presence of the goods and the execution of the assignment in general.
- Of all instructions relating to the protection of employees.
- The goods should bear all necessary marks in connection with their characteristics.
- The Client shall guarantee the accuracy, completeness and reliability of the data and documents made available to the Contractor (logistics provider) coming from him or from third parties. The Contractor (logistics provider) shall have the right to suspend the execution of the agreement until the Client has complied with the above-mentioned obligations. Any additional costs and damages resulting therefrom shall be for the Client's account.

The Client must make the goods packed in suitable, sufficient and transport-safe packaging, accompanied by an accompanying document, available to the Contractor (logistics service provider).

Here we refer to the "EU directive 2014/47" and in particular "EUMOS standard 40509 Transport packaging"

This standard requires the Client to offer stable loading units and sets tough requirements for the forces a load must be able to withstand.

A load may not exceed a certain degree of slope, even after repeated braking.

This standard also shifts the carrier's liability to the Client in case of damage.

Formula for calculating loading metres :

Length pallet x width pallet / 2.4

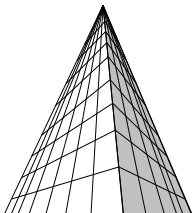
Payment term 30 days from date of invoice.
